Romans 4:5: "To him that worketh not, but believeth on Him...his faith is counted for righteousness"

James 2:24: "... Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only"

<u>Ephesians 2:8-10</u>: "For by grace are ye saved through faith...not of works...we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus *unto* good works"

<u>Titus 3:5-8,14</u>: "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us...they which have believed in God might be careful to *maintain* good works...that they be not unfruitful"

Colossians 1:26: "Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest..."

Acts 15:15: "...to this agree the words of the prophets...."

Romans 12:5: "So we, being many, are one body in Christ..."

I Corinthians 10:17: "For we being many are...one body"

<u>I Corinthians 12:12</u>: "...the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ"

<u>I Corinthians 12:13</u>: "For by one Spirit are we all baptized into *one body*, whether we be Jews or Gentiles"

<u>I Corinthians 12:18</u>: "Now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased Him"

I Corinthians 12:27: "Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular"

Ephesians 4:4: "There is one body..."

Acts 26:17: "...the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee"

Acts 11:18: "Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life"

Acts 14:27: "God...had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles"

<u>Luke 13:6</u>: "A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none"

<u>Luke 13:7</u>: "Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and fine none; *cut it down;* why cumbereth it the ground?"

<u>Luke 13:8,9</u>: "And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: And if it bear fruit, well: and if not, *then after that* thou shalt cut it down"

<u>I Thessalonians 2:16</u>: "...the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost"

Romans 11:12: "...the fall of them..."

Acts 13:46: "It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles"

<u>II Chronicles 36:5,6</u>: "Jehoikim…began to reign…Against him came up Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and bound him…Nebuchadnezzar also *carried of the vessels of the house of the Lord* to Babylon, and put them in his temple at Babylon"

II Chronicles 36:9,10: "Jehoichin...began to reign...And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar...brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the Lord"

<u>II Chronicles 36:18</u>: "And *all* the vessels of the house of God... *all* these he brought to Babylon. And they burnt the house of God..."

<u>Romans 11:25</u>: "I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant *of this mystery...*that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in"
