

Ezra 3:1 *Cross References*

Exodus 23:17: “Three times in the year all thy males shall appear *before the Lord God*”

Leviticus 23:24: “Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, *In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets...*”

Jeremiah 4:5: “Blow ye the trumpet in the land: cry, *gather together*, and say, *Assemble yourselves...*”

Matthew 13:30: “...in the time of harvest, I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: *but gather the wheat into My barns*”

Ezekiel 37:19: “Thus saith the Lord...I will take...*Israel...*and will put them with...*Judah*, and make them *one...*and *they shall be one in Mine hand*”

Acts 2:46; 4:32: “And they, continuing daily *with one accord...*were of *one heart and of one soul...*”

Matthew 24:31: “*He shall send his angels* with a great sound of a trumpet, and *they shall gather together* His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other”

Leviticus 23:24,25: “...a memorial of blowing of trumpets...Ye shall do no servile work therein: *but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord*”

Matthew 12:5: “...on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, *and are blameless*”

II Chronicles 36:19: “they burnt the house of God, *and brake down the wall of Jerusalem*”

Deuteronomy 28:15,50-52: “...*if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the Lord...*a nation of fierce countenance...shall besiege thee in all thy gates, *until thy high and fenced walls come down, wherein thou trustedst, throughout all thy land...*”

Zechariah 2:4,5: “Jerusalem shall be inhabited *as towns without walls...*for I, saith the Lord, will be unto her *a wall of fire round about...*”

Isaiah 26:1: “In that day...*salvation will God appoint for walls...*”

Exodus 29:38-41: “...offer upon the altar; two lambs...the one lamb thou shalt offer *in the morning*; and the other lamb thou shalt offer *at even...*an offering made by fire...*a continual burnt offering* throughout your generations...”

Galatians 6:7,8: “...God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. *For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption...*”

Matthew 17:1-4: “Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John...into an high mountain...and was transfigured before them: *and His face did shine as the sun*, and His raiment was white as the light...then answered Peter...Lord, it is good for us to be here...*let us make here three tabernacles...*”

Leviticus 23:34-40: “...the feast of tabernacles...ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, *branches of palm trees...*”

John 12:12,13: “...much people...when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of *palm trees*, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: *Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord*”

Psalms 137:1-3: “By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion...they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and...required of us mirth, saying, *Sing us one of the songs of Zion*”

Ephesians 2:4-6: “God...hath raised us up together, *and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus*”

Haggai 2:3: “Who is left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do ye see it now? is it not in your eyes in comparison of it *as nothing?*”

Zechariah 4:9,10: “The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house...*who hath despised the day of small things?*”

Haggai 2:3,4: “...is it not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing? Yet now *be strong*, O Zerubbabel, saith the Lord; and *be strong*, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and *be strong*, all ye people of the land, saith the Lord, *and work: for I am with you, saith the Lord of hosts*”

II Kings 17:24-33: “the king of Assyria brought men...and placed them in the cities of Samaria *instead of the children of Israel*...then the king of Assyria commanded, saying, Carry thither one of the priests whom ye brought from thence; and...let him teach them the manner of the God of the land. Then one of the priests...and taught them how they should fear the Lord. *Howbeit every nation made gods of their own*”

John 4:9: “...the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans”

John 4:22: “Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews”

II Kings 17:41: “So they feared the Lord, and served their own gods...*and served their graven images*”

I John 2:1,2: “...we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: *and He is the propitiation for our sins...*”
