

Ezra 6:15 *Cross References*

John 10:22: "...it was at Jerusalem *the feast of the dedication*, and it was winter..."

Psalms 81:3: "Blow up the trumpet *in the new moon* in the time appointed, *on our solemn feast day*"

Ezekiel 45:17: "...the feasts...*the new moons*...the sabbaths...*all* solemnities of the house of Israel..."

Romans 14:5: "One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. *Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind*"

II Corinthians 8:2: "...*the abundance of their joy* and their deep poverty *abounded unto the riches of their liberality*"

II Chronicles 7:5: "And king Solomon offered a sacrifice of *twenty and two thousand oxen, and an hundred and twenty thousand sheep*: so the king and all the people dedicated the house of God"

Zechariah 4:10: "...who hath despised the day of small things?"

Mark 12:42-44: "And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing. And He called unto Him His disciples, and saith unto them...*this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury*: For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in *all that she had*, even all her living"

II Chronicles 11:16,17: "...*out of all the tribes of Israel* such as set their hearts to seek the Lord God of Israel *came to Jerusalem*, to sacrifice unto the Lord God of their fathers. *So they strengthened the kingdom of Judah*"

Numbers 19:13: "Whosoever...*purifieth* not himself...because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him, he shall be unclean..."

II Chronicles 29:34: "...the Levites were more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests"

Ephesians 5:25,26: "Christ...loved the church, and gave Himself for it; that He might sanctify and cleanse it *with the washing of water by the word*"

Titus 2:13,14: "...our Saviour Jesus Christ...gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, *and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works*"

II Corinthians 7:1: "...let us *cleanse ourselves* from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God"

Exodus 12:48: “And when *a stranger* shall sojourn with thee, *and will keep the passover*...let all his males be circumcised, and *then* let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one that is born in the land...”

I Corinthians 5:6: “...a little leaven *leaveneth the whole lump*”

I Corinthians 5:7,8: “Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ *our Passover* is sacrificed for us. Therefore *let us keep the feast*, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth”

Jeremiah 52:24-27: “And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest...to the king of Babylon...and the king of Babylon smote them, *and put them to death*...thus Judah was carried away captive out of his own land”

II Kings 22:8: “And *Hilkiah the high priest* said...I have found the book of the law in the house of the Lord...”

Psalms 106:28: “They joined themselves also unto Baalpeor, and ate the sacrifices of the dead. Thus they provoked Him to anger...*then stood up Phinehas*, and executed judgment...”

Proverbs 22:29: “Seest thou a man *diligent* in his business? *He shall stand before kings*; he shall not stand before mean men”

I Samuel 7:3: “If ye do return unto the Lord with all your hearts, then put away the strange gods...from among you, *and prepare your hearts unto the Lord, and serve Him only*...”

II Chronicles 19:3: “...there are good things found in thee, in that thou hast taken away the groves out of the land, *and hast prepared thine heart to seek God*”

II Chronicles 20:33: “...the high places were not taken away; *for as yet the people had not prepared their hearts unto the God of their fathers*”

Colossians 3:5: “...covetousness, *which is idolatry*”

Genesis 12:1-3: “Now the Lord had said unto Abram...*I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee*...”

Hosea 1:9: “Loammi...*not My people*...”
